Discuss Santa Fe's history with local historians, archeologists, preservation trades professionals, and your peers while developing your own research project.





ABOUT US

Since its founding in 1961, the Historic Santa Fe Foundation (HSFF) has been an active participant in the preservation efforts in the city of Santa Fe and Northern New Mexico and a contributor to the historic narrative told through the region's people and architecture. Our mission is *to preserve, protect and promote the historic properties and diverse cultural heritage of the Santa Fe area, and to educate the public about Santa Fe's history and the importance of preservation.*



THE PROGRAM

The Fellowship provides high school juniors and seniors the opportunity to examine Santa Fe's history and related contemporary issues with local historians, archeologists, and preservation trades professionals.

Participating students will spend the academic year 2023-2024 meeting in historic properties across Santa Fe where they will participate in discussions on history while working on a research paper. The topics of the meetings will include:

- Santa Fe's built environment
- Cultural events
- Contemporary discourse on history and preservation

Students will publicly deliver their capstone project at the end of the program.

FELLOWSHIP AWARD

Fellows shall be awarded a sum of \$500 for college tuition once they have attended all sessions, submitted their final research paper, and presented their work at the final reception.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

The application consists of several short answer questions. Submission of a writing sample and letter of recommendation from a secondary teacher or counselor is required for a complete application.

- Fellows must be in 11th or 12th grade during the Fellowship
- Reside in Santa Fe County or the surrounding area
- Minimum GPA of 3.0

Applications are open through October 1, 2023.
